APPLICABILITY

This policy applies to all Board, Sub Committees, Affiliated Members and their Members. All volunteers, spectators and other participants of Success Netball Association Activities.

CHANGES TO THIS POLICY

This Policy may be cancelled, amended, or supplemented by the Association as and when it sees fit. Any variation will be emailed to Clubs and Entity Teams by the Association and uploaded to our website. The Association will review this policy on a regular basis to ensure that it remains effective in supporting the objectives and strategic direction of the Association, and to ensure ongoing best practice.

INTENT OF POLICY

To provide clarification to athletes, parents, coaches and officials for those selected into the Fuel to Go and Play Championship Weekend and any other competitions entered into by Success Netball Association. (SNA)

THE POLICY

1. Selected players must be prepared to make themselves available for ALL training sessions and the tournament. Work, school or other commitments will not be accepted for non-attendance at the tournament. Players who continually miss training may be replaced in the team by a selected reserve.
2. Coaches must ensure that all players take the court on three (3) occasions in order to qualify for finals.
3. Apart from rule 2, there is NO EQUAL COURT TIME.
4. Selected players are required to:
 - a. Carry out all training as set by the coach and attend all coaching sessions as arranged.
 - b. Return in good order the Association Uniform and any other SNA property within the timeframes advised.
 - c. Behave in an acceptable manner at all times whilst representing SNA both on and off the court.
 - d. Show sportsmanship at all times.
 - e. Give full co-operation to all team and Association officials.
 - f. Accept the coach's decisions on team placements.
 - g. Bring to the attention of the Team Captain or Team Manager any problems within the team or any off-court problems.
 - h. Attend the Presentation Wind-Up.
5. Team Captain

Team Captains will be selected in a manner decided by the Team Coach and will be ratified by the Association Development Officer (ADO). Team Captains are expected to:

- a. Bring to the attention of the Team Manager or ADO any significant issues or conflicts within the team that are unable to be settled.
 - b. Encourage the team to support other SNA teams at the tournament.
 - c. Act in a sportsmanlike manner at all times and encourage all team members to be proactive with regards to shaking hands after the game.
 - d. Liaise with the Team Manager with regard to coin toss result.
6. Team Fees
- a. Fees shall be decided by the SNA Board each year. Fees must be paid in full by the date as advised by the Association and include a player presentation cost. Fees are non-refundable. In the event of an injury, a written application for a refund will only be considered by the Board if accompanied by a Medical Certificate. Administration costs may be deducted from any successful application.
7. Team Managers
- a. Team Managers will be selected or co-opted by the Team Coach in Consultation with the ADO.
 - b. Team Manager's duties will be as per their Duty Statement.
 - c. Team Managers are to be provided with a copy of the Association Member Ethics Clause.
8. Umpires
- a. Umpires for trials shall be co-ordinated by the Association Umpire Development Officer (AUDO). The Association reserves the right to call upon the clubs that the players trialling represents (on a proportional basis) to supply umpires for trials. Failure to do so may result in players' applications being refused. Umpires for the tournament shall be organised by the AUDO.
