

## UNIFORM POLICY

### APPLICABILITY

This policy applies to all Board, Sub Committees, Affiliated Members and their Members. All volunteers, spectators and other participants of Success Netball Association Activities.

### CHANGES TO THIS POLICY

This Policy may be cancelled, amended, or supplemented by the Association as and when it sees fit. Any variation will be emailed to Clubs and Entity Teams by the Association and uploaded to our website. The Association will review this policy on a regular basis to ensure that it remains effective in supporting the objectives and strategic direction of the Association, and to ensure ongoing best practice.

### INTENT OF POLICY

The policy is to ensure that Success Netball Association (Inc) provides a policy for clubs in relation to registered Club uniform, registered club colours and requirements of players in relation to uniforms and associated matters.

#### Winter Season – NetSetGo, Juniors and Opens

1. No two (2) clubs shall have the same uniform.
2. For female participants: skirt and top or dress. Sports brief or bike shorts (to be no longer than the skirt or dress can be worn under the skirt / dress).
3. For male participants: shorts and top.
4. For gender diverse participants: the uniform will be the discretion of the SNA Board and an exemption may be applied for.
5. Long sleeve fitted sports tops are permitted to be worn under the club's uniform if it is the same colour of the clubs approved uniform or black.
6. Set & GO players only may wear long sleeve tops under the club uniform, providing they are the same colour as the approved uniform (or black).
7. Colours and uniforms for new clubs, where possible need be submitted to the SNA Board by the 14 February and no club shall make any change to this uniform without first obtaining the consent of the SNA Board. A photograph of the uniform must be supplied to the SNA Board with the submission, and no deviation to that photographic example will be allowed.
8. Priority of registration shall determine the exclusive right to wear the particular uniform or colours.
9. Permission to play out of uniform must be obtained from the Competition Committee or SNA Board prior to taking the court. Refer Exemption Policy
10. Sports shoes only shall be worn.

11. No teams may use National colours, WA State colours or SNA colours.
12. If a club does not register for two years their name and colours become available to new or existing clubs wishing to change their name or colours.
13. Clubs who have different playing uniforms within the club must register each uniform.
14. All players in Finals Matches must play in that team's uniform. Failure to do so will be deemed as playing an ineligible player. [Refer Fines and Penalties Table](#).
15. A fill in player will be a player using a [Single Game Voucher](#) or a player playing up from a lower division. Players who play on an SGV must wear the team uniform or one that closely resembles it. The 'Correct Uniform' will be left to the discretion of the Competitions Committee or SNA Board. If the player is not in the team uniform, an exemption must be obtained from the Competitions Committee or SNA Board. Failure to do so may result in fine or penalty. [Refer Fines and Penalties Table](#)
16. The SNA Board may allow a period of grace at the beginning of the winter season if a club can prove that they are subject to uniform delays by a supplier.
17. The Board reserves the right to request a team to alter any part of their uniform if deemed inappropriate by the Board.
18. Any requests for variation to uniforms will be viewed at the discretion of the Board.

#### **Spring Season – NetSetGo, Juniors and Opens**

1. Uniforms must be consistent across all players including fill-ins.
2. Uniform colours must be recorded in Play HQ upon team registration.

#### **Mens Competition**

1. If player registrations are club based all players must be in club colours in a uniform approved by the Board. Refer Winter Competition (above)
2. If player registrations are SNA based, uniform consistency is at the discretion of the Competitions Committee.

#### **Walking Netball**

1. If player registrations are club based all players must be in club colour in a uniform approved by the Board. This uniform may be different from the traditional netball code of dress. Refer Winter Competition (above).
2. If player registrations are SNA based, uniform consistency is at the discretion of the Competitions Committee.

#### **No Limits Netball**

1. If player registrations are club based all players must be in club colour in a uniform approved by the Board. This uniform may be different from the traditional netball code of dress. Refer Winter Competition (above).
2. If player registrations are SNA based, uniform consistency is at the discretion of the Competitions Committee.
