APPLICABILITY

This policy applies to all Board, Sub Committees, Affiliated Members and their Members. All volunteers, spectators and other participants of Success Netball Association Activities.

CHANGES TO THIS POLICY

This Policy may be cancelled, amended, or supplemented by the Association as and when it sees fit. Any variation will be emailed to Clubs and Entity Teams by the Association and uploaded to our website. The Association will review this policy on a regular basis to ensure that it remains effective in supporting the objectives and strategic direction of the Association, and to ensure ongoing best practice.

INTENT OF POLICY

The Netball WA No Limits Netball Program is a participation-based program for individuals aged over 12 years old with an intellectual disability. Each No Limits Netball Program sites deliver weekly training programs and/or competitions to advance social and physical skills as well as drive overall mental wellbeing. These training sessions then lead into the No Limits division at the annual Fuel 2 Go and Play Association Championships, with teams competing in a one-day competition over the carnival weekend.

The following competition rules apply:

1. This competition is an inclusive mixed gender division for participants 12 years and older with an intellectual disability. Any exceptions to these age restrictions will be at the discretion of the SNA Board and must be communicated and approved in writing prior to the competition.
2. Player participation in the No Limits division is an acknowledgement that they have a classified intellectual disability.
3. There are no restrictions on the number of any gender that are required in each team or on the court at any given time. There are no positional rules for males, however it is recommended that if teams have two or three males that teams equally allocate these players across each third.
4. All players must be registered as a No Limits Program via Play HQ to participate in the Fuel to Go and Play Association Championships. Though out the program we offer a come and try session. However on the next session the player will need to be registered via Play HQ
5. There is no uniform direction however all players who participate in the Fuel to Go and Play Association Championships must wear an SNA playing top. (To be provided)
6. If there are more than 1 team players will be grouped in teams with similar abilities.
7. All players and officials are to compete, communicate and make decisions within the spirit of the game in the best interest of including everyone.
