APPLICABILITY

This policy applies the Mens Competition held at Success Netball Association.

CHANGES TO THIS POLICY

This Policy may be cancelled, amended, or supplemented by the Association as and when it sees fit. Any variation will be emailed to Clubs and Entity Teams by the Association and uploaded to our website. The Association will review this policy on a regular basis to ensure that it remains effective in supporting the objectives and strategic direction of the Association, and to ensure ongoing best practice.

INTENT OF POLICY

To create a competition to allow for participation of men at Success Netball Association.

The purpose of this Policy is to clarify how the men's competition will run and what rules have been modified from our Competition Handbook.

THE POLICY

All games of Netball are played according to the International Rules of Netball.

Modified Rules are:

UNIFORM

- 1. If player registrations are club based all players must be in club colours in a uniform approved by the Board. Refer <u>Uniform Policy Winter Competition</u>
- 2. If player registrations are SNA based, uniform consistency is at the discretion of the Competitions Committee or SNA Board.
- 3. Refer Mens Competition within the Uniform Policy.

ROLLING SUBSTITUTIONS

Teams will be allowed to make substitutions during play, this includes during stoppages and intervals. There is no limit to the number of substitutions that can be made during a match and more than one substitution may be made at any time. Play will not be held for rolling substitutions (umpires do not need to be notified if a player wishes to complete a substitution).

SINGLE GAME VOUCHER

A Single Game Voucher (SGV) is a voucher that is used for a fill in player. This provides insurance cover for the player in the event of an injury. Failure to purchase an SGV prior to the commencement of the game will be classified as playing an ineligible player. Refer to playing an ineligible player in the Competition Handbook.

- 1. The SGV is available from SNA Administration prior to the start of the game or clubs can complete the online form during the week prior to the game https://forms.gle/YQgSRB3dvenrbs5C6
- 2. Refer Single Game Voucher Policy
- 3. There are NO maximum number of SGV per team per week.

IDENTIFIED ATHLETE

An Identified Athlete is a person who is a current playing member of:

- 1. a Suncorp Super Netball (SSN) team;
- 2. an Australian Netball Championship (ANC) team;
- 3. a West Australian Netball League (WANL) team;
- 4. a National Netball Championship (NNC) team, or;
- 5. a team in an equivalent competition to those listed above in another State, Territory, or country;

An Identified Athlete will NOT have their participation in the Mens Competition restricted.
